<u>Band Students grades 5-8</u> – 2-inch three ring binder, spiral notebook <u>Choir Students</u> – 1-inch black binder, pencils (no pens), composition notebook <u>Art</u> - #2 wood pencils – No mechanical

All students need to supply 2 boxes of Kleenex to their homeroom teacher

Elementary School Supply Lists

Requirement: Tennis shoes for physical education class. Additional supplies may be requested by the individual classroom teacher. Due to limited space, please do not bring trapper keepers and backpacks should not have wheels.

<u>Kindergarten</u> – A backpack and \$6.50 fee for Weekly Reader. Your child's teacher will have a supply list specific to their classroom.

First Grade – A backpack, 1 box of #2 yellow pencils with erasers, box of 24 Crayola crayons, thin washable markers, 1 pkg. of Expo dry-erase markers, 1 box of Kleenex, scissors (prefer Fiskar blunt tip), 6 glue sticks, 1 bottle of liquid glue, 1 pocket folder, 1 large eraser, 1 bottle of pump hand sanitizer, 1 package of Lysol wipes, 1 box gallon size baggies (prefer Ziploc), small plastic school supply box **for Mrs. Mishler, Mrs. Lasley ONLY.**

<u>Second Grade</u> – A backpack, 2 boxes of #2 sharpened pencils with erasers, a large eraser, a 12oz. bottle of hand sanitizer, 24 pack of crayons, 1 set of colored pencils, 2 boxes of Kleenex, scissors, large bottle of glue, 4 glue sticks, 4 pocket folders, a ruler w/inches and centimeters, small school box or pouch, 3 spiral-bound notebooks (70 pages each), one 4-pack low odor dry erase markers, \$6.00 fee for Weekly Reader..
