JUDGMENT OF CONVICTION AND SENTENCE

Comes now the State of Indiana by Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Tara Coats Hunt and comes now the defendant in person and by counsel, David Smith, having been found guilty by Jury Trial on November 30th, 2019 of COUNT 1, Guilty but Mentally Ill at the time of the offense of Murder, a Felony; COUNT 2, Guilty but Mentally ill at the time of the offense of Felony Murder and COUNT 3, Guilty of Arson and the Probation Office having filed Pre-Sentence Investigation Report with the Court, parties appear for sentencing.

The Court having heard testimony and arguments now finds and ORDERS that the defendant is sentenced as follows:

1. SENTENCE

COUNT 2 Felony Murder and COUNT 3 Arson shall be MERGED Into COUNT 1 MURDER, a FELONY.

The total sentence to the Indiana Department of Correction is

- a. **Count 1, MURDER; _60_ years; _0_ days of the period of imprisonment herein shall be suspended with _60_ years to be executed as set out below.**

2. AGGREGATE SENTENCE

Defendant is sentenced to the Indiana Department of Correction as follows: Defendant shall serve _60_ years.

3. CREDIT FOR TIME SERVED & BEGINNING SENTENCE DATE

Defendant has served _665_ actual days in jail and earned _222_ credit days for a total of _887_ days to be applied to his sentence in this charge.

4. FINES AND COSTS

Defendant shall pay the Court costs of this action herein taxed in the sum of \$185.00; \$100.00 Public Defender Fee.

11. AGGRAVATING FACTORS

The aggravating factors considered by the Court are:

- A. The harm, injury, loss or damage suffered by the victim of the offense was greater than the elements necessary to prove the commission of the crime.
- B. The victim was disabled.
- C. The defendant has a history of substance abuse.
- D. Defendant has shown no lack of remorse.

12. MITIGATING FACTORS

The mitigating factors include:

- A. The defendant has no documented history of criminal history
- B. The defendant is considered to have mental illness

13. INCARCERATION AND TRANSPORTATION

The Sheriff of Washington County is hereby charged with due execution of the foregoing Judgment.

14. PAYMENT OF COSTS, FINES AND FEES

Defendant shall pay the fees of this action to the Clerk of the Washington Superior Court.

15. DNA TESTING

Defendant agrees to give a DNA sample pursuant to I.C. 10-13-16-1.


16. OTHER
